Eulogy and Family Reflections at the time of a Funeral

It is the policy of the Diocese of Columbus that the preferred time for a remembrance or eulogy is during the vigil service (CF, Prot. 10/97, #4). It should be brief (no more than three minutes) and delivered by one person who is reasonably adept at public speaking.

It is the policy of St. John Paul II Scioto Catholic Parish to not permit any eulogy or remembrance to take place during a funeral service at any of our church campuses.

If the family does not gather prior to the funeral liturgy, a brief remembrance may be given at the conclusion of the graveside service, or preferably, at the meal following the service.
